

There is, in the City of Prince George in central BC, a unique historical site. It is a burial ground sacred to the Lheidli T'enneh Nation, a legal Indian Reserve within Fort George Park in the city, and it has been in use for about 135 years. This is a study of the origins and changes in that cemetery.
